Meeting called to order at 4:17 p.m. Roll call: Diane Olson, Mark Peterson and Bill Evans. Clerk Kent Hatlestad also present. Minutes: Motion Peterson, second Olson to approve minutes from the last meeting. All aye, motion approved. Appearances: Jeff Cermak – Town of Bergen President

Unfinished Business: Discussion on changing zoning. Zoning amendment 4.05 4) (a), (c) and (d) proposal

4) Routes

The Village of Stoddard establishes the following ATV routes:

- (a) Under Wis. Stat. 23.33(8)(b)2., the Village of Stoddard designates all Village-maintained public streets as ATV routes, except as otherwise posted.
- (b) Under Wis. Stat. 23.33(11)(am)4., the Village of Stoddard authorizes the operation of ATVs on STH 162 (Division Street) where the posted speed limit is 35 mph or less within the Village's territorial boundary.
- (c) ATVs shall not be operated on any other State Trunk Highway within the Village territorial boundary unless directly crossing from one village maintained public street to another.
- (d) Access to the Stoddard Park on STH 162 (Division Street) is prohibited to ATV traffic.

The following streets are golf cart routes:

- a) All Village of Stoddard maintained public streets with a speed limit of 25 mph or less within the territorial boundaries of the Village of Stoddard are designated as a golf cart route, rendering all such roadways accessible to golf cart traffic.
- b) Golf carts shall not be operated on State Trunk Highways unless crossing in a designated golf cart crossing area.
- c) Designated golf cart crossing areas:
 - 1. Center Street and Main Street (STH 35);
 - 2. Broadway Street and Main Street (STH 35).
- d) Access to the Stoddard Park on STH 162 (Division Street) is prohibited to golf cart traffic.

The Park Committee requested that the ordinance be changed to allow ATV/UTV use in the park. ATV/UTV and golf carts must stay on paved areas. A designated crossing for golf carts must also be added from Cottage St. directly to the park entrance.

Hatlestad will work the village attorney on preparing proposed changes to the ordinance.

New Business:

Discussion on conditional use permits moving forward in C-1 District. Tabled.

Discussion on property annexation proposal. Hatlestad reported on two properties on Lake Road that would benefit from being annexed into the Town of Bergen. Hatlestad brought up the fact that several very small property parcels along Lake Road are also in the Village. This might be a good time to clean up that area. Cermak said he would take the request to his board for discussion.

Discussion on Building permits: Michael Mosher - 330 S. Pearl St. - Deck. Motion Peterson, second Olson to approve. All aye, motion carried.

Discussion on new equipment. pH sensor must be replaced and a new chart recorder is needed in the lift station.

Discussion on Cindy Davis private well installation. Hatlestad reported that all testing and forms had been filed. Motion Bolton, second Young to approve private well permit at 409 S. Pearl St. All aye, motion carried.
